



Use of "Fair Play" in Invitational Tournaments

Fair Play Tournament Rule:

A Fair Play point will be awarded to each team for every applicable invitational tournament game per "Fair Play" rules designated in Section VIII. PLAYING RULES, Q. Fair Play, Rules 2, 3 and 4.

a. For bracket format tournaments, in the event of a tie at the end of regulation play, if one of the tied teams has earned their Fair Play point and the other team has not, the team having earned the Fair Play point will be designated the winner of the game. If both teams have earned their Fair Play point or both teams have not earned their Fair Play point, the next tiebreaker will be determined by the tournament. This shall apply to all games except the final "Championship" game.

b. For round robin format tournaments, pool play standings will be determined by including the Fair Play point along with any other points awarded in pool play including points for a win or a tie.
